<u>Training outline:</u>

Leadership continues to be an important focus for Head Start and Early Head Start. The sessions at the Institute this summer will continue in that tradition.

Here are the topics and the presenters:

Brain mapping: Understanding the Brain and Behavior. Brain imaging methods are more easily accessible. Dr. Yip will discuss how brain mapping results can support early intervention strategies and how these efforts can lead to a better understanding of behavior and inform and guide treatment. Attendees will hear about results from case histories of individuals with brain conditions such as trauma, reactive attachment disorder, autism, ADHD, depression, addiction, learning disabilities, dyslexia and others.

Dr. Jane Yip, presenter, is the founder of Indiana Brain Mapping. She is a neurosurgeon specializing in brain circuitry, and has scientific publications on brain disorders. She has helped hundreds of individuals understand their symptoms in association with the brain.

Staff Engagement and Retention and Staffing Perils. Dr. Hobson will focus on the critical issues of engagement and retention, as well as principles to support quality professional practices. He will share lessons learned from some of America's top companies. He will review the "Stay Interview" process by Rich Finnegan (A manager's guide to keeping the best and brightest), and explain its application.

Dr. Charles Hobson, presenter, is a professor of Business Administration at IU Northeast, and is currently the interim Dean of the School of Education. He is affiliated with The Center for Management Development in the School of Business and Economics. He focuses on supervisory and human resources management and organization behavior. His research interests include team development and leadership.

Promoting Children's Mathematical Inquiry through Play. (This training session is sponsored by Frog Street Press.)

Play provides a natural context for children to accomplish important cognitive and linguistic milestones. This workshop reviews empirical research and theory about how children learn through play. Participants will make practical connections to theory by learning ways to scaffold and guide children in productive self-selected exploratory and pretend play scenarios that integrate knowledge and skills related to mathematics.

Dr. Brian Mowry, presenter, is a well-known speaker at national and regional conferences as he shares his knowledge and expertise in the field of Early Childhood Education. In addition to his authorship within the Frog Street Curriculum Continuum and the new Frog Street Assessment, he has co-authored various scholarly articles as well as the up-coming text called Rigorous DAP in the Early Years: From Theory to Practice
